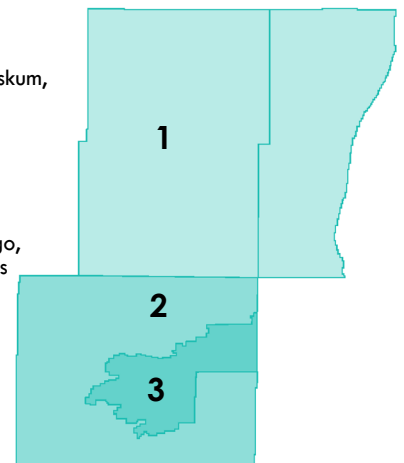

TRAIN & RETAIN.

Our training services include:

- **On-the-job Training (OJT)****

The OJT program is used to provide incentives to businesses who hire new employees who have the aptitude and ability to do a specific job but do not have previous on-the-job experience in that occupation or industry.

Businesses save an average of \$4,500 per new hire. Wage reimbursements are designed to help offset the extraordinary costs of training new hires. The length of the OJT and wage reimbursement is dependent on the amount of training needed and the complexity of the job.

- **Incumbent Worker Training****

We recognize the need for continued training for individuals not only who are in the job seeking process but also for those who are currently employed. As a result of local business needs, we can assist offset the cost of training incumbent workers who receive industry recognized credentials, are promoted to new positions, and/or receive wage increases.

- **Work-Based Learning****
